


Perhaps you could go for a wander or look out of the window to see if you can see God's glory anywhere?

Verse 3: 'Who of you is left who saw this house in its former glory? How does it look to you now? Does it not seem to you like nothing?'




I wonder if trees lose their glory when they lose their leaves?

When have you connected with **OTHERS**


What do you need to **RELEASE**
